



# **Vogue Theatrical Paint - F000 Series**

# **Product Description**

The finest quality non-reflective bold, deep colors for theater, television and photography industries. These acrylic products are fast drying and provide a better backdrop than tinted formulations.

## **Recommended Use**

Theatrical stages, sets, television production, photography studios and areas where a non-reflective coating is desired.

# **General Surface Preparation**

Surfaces must be clean and free from dirt, dust, grease, oil or peeling paint. A white powdery deposit (efflorescence) often found on masonry surfaces, should be completely removed with a stiff wire brush. Repair cracks and imperfections with Muralo Spackle.

### Application

Stir before use.

Brush: Use nylon or synthetic bristle brushes for best results. Avoid brushing back into paint after it has been on the surface for more than five minutes. Allow paint to dry completely before touching up.

Roller: For best results, use a good quality 3/8 inch nap roller for smooth surfaces and 1/2 inch or longer nap for rougher surfaces. Be sure to allow paint to dry before touching up.

Spray: Conventional airless application. For best results, use equipment manufacturer's recommendations.

#### Clean up

A mixture of warm water and mild soap is the best cleaning solution for water-based paints. Prepare soapy water and pour into a clean container. Dip the paint brush into the mixture, working the soap through the brush bristles. Follow with a clear water rinse. Repeat the process if necessary. Always use a clean container with clean soapy water and follow with a clear water rinse. For stubborn water-based paints, try mineral spirits or lacquer thinner, followed by warm soapy water and a clear water rinse.
