



Latex Block Filler - F515 Series

Product Description

This alkali resistant block filler is formulated to fill pores and small voids in masonry and light aggregate block. This ready-mixed Interior/Exterior vinyl acrylic block filler eliminates pin holing and produces a uniform surface texture ready for finish coating.

Recommended Use

Concrete Block, Porous Masonry and Concrete

General Surface Preparation

Masonry block should be "bricked down" so that all concrete nibs and projections are removed from the surface. Loose mortar, dirt, dust, grease and oil must also be removed before applying FixAll Block Filler F51500. Large concrete voids or cracks should be patched with an appropriate oil free patching material before painting. Concrete and mortar must be cured, generally 30 days, before coating. Moisture content must be 14% or lower, and the pH between 6 and 9.

Application

FixAll Latex Block Filler/Primer is supplied ready-to-use but can be thinned sparingly with water if necessary. It can be applied by brush, roller or spray.

Brush - Use a synthetic nylon or polyester brush and apply material generously to the surface. Work the Filler into the masonry until all voids and hairline cracks are filled. Material should be finished brushed in one direction to create an even appearance. Roller - Use a synthetic or lambs wool 3/8" - 3/4" nap roller cover. Work material into block and finish roll horizontally. Spray - ProPaint Block Filler is silica free and can be successfully sprayed without doing physical damage to spray equipment. Heavy duty airless units using a .021 to .028 tip are ideal for large scale block filler applications.

Clean up

A mixture of warm water and mild soap is the best cleaning solution for water-based paints. Prepare soapy water and pour into a clean container. Dip the paint brush into the mixture, working the soap through the brush bristles. Follow with a clear water rinse. Repeat the process if necessary. Always use a clean container with clean soapy water and follow with a clear water rinse. For stubborn water-based paints, try mineral spirits or lacquer thinner, followed by warm soapy water and a clear water rinse.

1 coat FixAll Latex Block Filler F51500

1 or 2 coats FixAll or California® Latex, Alkyd or Oil-modified Urethane in desired finish.

Precautions

Do not add solvents, oils or colors in oil, or mix with other paint types. Do not apply when air or surface temperature is below 50 °F or when drying conditions are poor. Keep from freezing. Do not use under catalyzed epoxies, epoxy polyesters or aliphatic urethanes.
